What you must submit to RU before March 27:

- All students need to apply online by **March 27th** (one week before appointment)
 - Application can be downloaded at:
<http://www.radford.edu/content/dam/departments/administrative/admissions/content-files/UGAdmissionApplication.pdf>
- Pay \$50 application fee or fee waiver
- Submit all official transcripts for any college level work attempted by **March 27th**, including dual-enrollment work to Radford University.
- Submit official high school transcript to Radford University for those who have not completed 24 credit hours or more and/or have not completed the appropriate college-level math.
- Submit to Radford University a time lapse statement if there is a gap of time after high school and/or between their college attendance that needs to be accounted for.

International Students:

- Submit the RU international admissions application online by **March 27th**
- Bring to their appointment- a copy of their visa, green card and/or other necessary documentation if they are not a U.S. citizen.

- Bring to their appointment- a bank statement and “Letter of Support” showing a minimum of \$33,736 available for their first year of studies at RU.
